An Announcement from the Office of the Mayor Coronavirus (COVID-19) Local Update

March 31, 2020

Our Haledon Community:

I hope you and your loved ones are doing well during these trying times. As of this writing, there are twenty (20) confirmed Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Haledon. Out of the twenty (20) Haledon residents that have tested positive, fortunately, six (6) residents have already recovered. It is encouraging to know that no residents are currently admitted in an Intensive Care Unit due to COVID-19. As testing availability becomes more accessible, we anticipate seeing a continual increase in positive cases.

The Passaic County Health Department continues to administer COVID-19 daily testing, Monday through Saturday, 9:00AM to 12:00PM, in Lot 6 of William Paterson University. In order to be tested at the William Paterson University testing site, you must be a Passaic County resident and you must have a prescription from a healthcare provider. If you are in need of a prescription, you may utilize the telehealth service being offered by Saint Joseph's University Medical Center for a fee. Please visit www.stjosephshealth.org/telehealth for more information regarding the telehealth program.

As a precautionary measure, Borough Hall offices continue to be closed to the public until further notice. The Recycling Center is also closed until further notice. Municipal payments are still being accepted at Borough Hall via drop-box. No cash will be accepted. We encourage residents to utilize online payment services, regular mail, email or telephone. All essential personnel, including police, fire and public works, are reporting for duty as scheduled. Alternate side of the street parking has been suspended and no citations will be issued for street cleaning parking violations during the State of Emergency. However, the street sweeper will still be deployed periodically to clean as much as practicable. Curbside trash pick-up is also being conducted as scheduled.


