Haledon's Second Presumptive Positive Coronavirus (COVID-19) Case

March 25, 2020

Our Haledon Community:

I regret to inform you that we have received confirmation from Passaic County Health Officials of the second presumptive positive COVID-19 test of a Haledon resident. The resident, who is a 61 year old male, is currently quarantined at home and being monitored by health-care professionals. The first case was a 46 year old Eastern Christian High School teacher who tested positive for COVID-19 on March 18, 2020.

We remain in constant communication with the Director of the Passaic County Department of Health and Human Services and the Haledon Board of Health. We will release additional information as it is provided and permitted to be released.

We must all be vigilant together in following the recommendations of public health officials as it pertains to social distancing, washing your hands frequently, covering coughs and sneezes and disinfecting common areas. Non-essential travel should be avoided, and we should all remain home as much as possible.

Should you exhibit any symptoms of illness, consult with your health care provider to discuss treatment options.

In an effort to proactively protect the health and welfare of our borough community, yesterday we issued a local state of emergency that included new restrictions. Please visit our borough website at www.haledonboronj.com for any updates.

I ask everyone to continue being patient as we continue to work to provide accurate information to the public. Stay well and we will all get through this pandemic together.
