"The Haledon Police Department expresses our sincere concern for the well-being and safe return of our neighbor, Felix Joel DeJesus, who went missing on the night of February 2, 2022. As time passes, our thoughts remain with Mr. DeJesus and his loved ones. We have diligently undertaken every effort within our means, working with local, county, state, and federal authorities to find answers. Rest assured, our resolve to bring closure to this situation is enduring. We are steadfast in our dedication to keeping hope alive and extend our deepest empathy to the DeJesus family, especially during this challenging time. Mr. DeJesus was last seen congregating with five (5) civilian witnesses in the area of Westside Park, behind John F. Kennedy High School, in the City of Paterson on February 2, 2022, at approximately 9:00PM. The whereabouts of Mr. DeJesus thereafter, remain under active investigation. Mr. DeJesus is described as a Hispanic male, age 43, 5'9" in height, and 200 pounds in weight, with a Puerto Rican flag tattoo on his chest. A photo of Mr. DeJesus accompanies this news release.
